

Color Dance Quilt Class

with Sandra Bruce

Supply list (please bring to class):

A sewing machine in good working order

Neutral thread for piecing (I like grey Aurifil 50 wt)

Sewing kit (the usual: scissors, seam ripper, pins, etc.)

Rotary cutter with a sharp blade

An Omnigrid (or other brand) ruler, at least 12 inches long

Marking tools for darks and lights (chalk, disappearing pen, etc.)

10-inch “window” (see below)

It’s very helpful to have a window to audition your finished 10” block. Take a 14-inch square piece of thin cardboard or thick paper and mark a 2-inch border around it with a pencil.

Using an exacto knife or paper scissors, cut out the inside 10-inch square.
