Supply list (*please bring to class*):

Sewing Machine in good working order with a 1/4 inch foot and a new sewing needle. Size 70/10 Schmetz Microtex needles are recommended for foundation paper piecing, and Size 60/8 Schmetz Microtex needles are recommended for sewing down the applique

- Scotch Brand Restickable glue stick is recommended. Alternately you can use a UHU or Scotch Brand Glue Stick
- Fons and Porter or Sewline fabric glue pen
- Roxanne's Glue-Baste-It – small size for the applique
- 12" Add-A-Quarter ruler and a piece of Template Plastic – about 12" by 3" to use as a straight edge for folding back the papers
- Purple Thang for Judy's turn under applique technique
- 1 box jumbo paper clips
- 2 large Ziploc storage bags
- Small iron and pressing surface.
- Rotary cutter and rulers for cutting your fabrics
- A good quality 50 weight cotton thread for piecing and a good quality 80 or 100 weight thread for sewing down the applique
- Small scissors, pins and other sewing notions you may need
