

“Honu, The Protector”
Class by Wendy Mathson
for Quilt Passions, Quilting on the Beach
Kona, Hawaii February, 2024

Class Description:

The beloved Hawaiian green sea turtle is the centerpiece for this wallhanging, which combines piecing and appliqué. For the pieced storm at sea section, Wendy will teach her “trim-after-you-sew” technique using her TRIMplate rulers. Or if you prefer paper piecing, all the paper foundations are supplied with the pattern.

2 day class

Skill level: Intermediate

Supply List

- Pattern: The Protector, Barbara Bieraugel Designs
 - Wendy Mathson’s TRIMplates: Bring the 8” SIS (Squares in Squares), and 8-6-4 Diamond if you already have them. **Purchase is not required.** Rulers will be supplied for students to use in class. They will be available for purchase at \$47 for the set.
 - If prefer to paper piece, I recommend an Add-an-Eighth ruler
 - Light to medium gray piecing thread
 - Threads to match fabric for machine or hand appliqué
 - Marking pen or pencil for fabric. (My favorite is a Sewline Trio Ceramic marking pencil which has 3 colors.)
- Rotary cutter with a new blade. 45mm recommended
- Any small ruler you like to use for cutting squares from strips
 - Cutting mat at least 8” square. A turntable mat is nice.
 - Standard sewing supplies such as fine pins, thread snips, scissors, seam ripper.
